St. Helena III Historic Canal Boat Rides On the Ohio & Erie Canal

The Canal Fulton Heritage Society offers school & youth groups the opportunity to experience life on the Ohio & Erie Canal during a historic field trip.

The field trip is designed to meet Ohio Academic Content Standards for Social Studies with a focus on 3rd-5th grades.

Your Education Packages may include:

- ❑ A horse-drawn ride on the St. Helena III replica canal boat with a historian relating canal history during the 1800's. (1 hour)
- ❑ View a 30 minute documentary video about life on the Ohio & Erie Canal at the Canalway Center.
- ❑ A visit to the Old Canal Days Museum where visitors can view canal era artifacts and photos. (30 minutes)
- ❑ A takeaway educational activity sheet on Canal History that meets content standards
- ❑ Tour of the Oberlin House. A restored and preserved, 1840's, "saltbox" style house. (45 minutes)
